### **Turquoise adds to its management team Ian Werner appointed as Head of Legal and Compliance**

*London, 19 February 2008* – Eli Lederman, Chief Executive of Turquoise, the multi-lateral trading facility being established by nine leading European investment banks, today announced that Ian Werner will join the senior management team later this month as Head of Legal and Compliance.

Until last autumn Mr Werner was the Manager of the Compliance and Investigations team at the London Stock Exchange (LSE) where he had responsibility for implementing the Rules of the LSE, investigating Rule breaches and enforcing the disciplinary process.
